Countywide Consortium's Stakeholder Meetings for the Development of the Five-Year Consolidated Plan

This fiscal year, the City is required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to complete a Five-Year Consolidated Plan that will cover the years 2010-2014. In the following years the City prepares a one-year plan; performance is reported annually in the ConPlan CAPER each September. As was reported earlier, this year, for the first time ever, the City is partnering with the County of Santa Clara and other cities within the County to develop a regional Five-Year Consolidated Plan (ConPlan). The ConPlan is a document that contains basic housing and community data and a market analysis, and identifies the community's housing and community needs. The ConPlan is a requirement for participating jurisdictions to qualify for federal entitlement funding. By creating a single plan, this informal consortium of cities and the urban County hopes to create common housing and community goals throughout the region.

Before the consultant can begin work on the ConPlan, three stakeholders' meetings are being held throughout Santa Clara County, in north, south, and central locations, to determine needs and gaps in services. The meeting in San José is scheduled to take place on **September 9th at 6:00 p.m.** at the West Valley Library. While the consortium is targeting nonprofits, businesses, and community leaders, the general public is welcome and encouraged to attend.
